Title: The Real Climate Deniers

Those peddling “climate change” insisting skeptics who have contrary evidence or who demand scientific method principles are “climate deniers” are the real deniers, and not at all scientific.

Climate change proponents call it a general, non-specific term; not manmade climate change, not global warming, not dangerous climate change. That’s because they lack scientific evidence proving those claims. Also, they do not follow the generally accepted scientific method.

The scientific method, long established as necessary to conduct reliable results, requires unbiased, reproducible data available to all. It welcomes and encourages rigorous review and critiques, to ensure the science and its conclusions are sound. It avoids exaggerated extrapolations and predictions, and, must include other causal factors’ dynamics. Climate change proponents won’t share data. The people behind the primary study routinely cited, resisted British Court orders to share the data, ultimately claiming to have “lost” it.

Climate change peddlers dismiss those asking for scientific process rigor, rather than debate them. Likely because most facts are on the side of skeptical scientists. Virtually all climate changers’ dire predictions haven’t happened. Attacking and shutting down opponents entirely, works better than debating facts.

Climate change advocates’ own estimates indicate full implementation would prevent at most 0.3°F of warming by the year 2100, costing \$23.3 to \$46.6 trillion per tenth of a degree. As the Wizard tells Dorothy to pay no attention to the man behind the curtain, they want us to pay no attention to the facts behind climate change.
